For example, your National Legislative Division in the Legion's DC office uses the final totals from this report to support American Legion Testimony, before appropriate Congressional Committees concerning such matter as nonprofit postal rates, income tax exemption, copyright exemption, state tax breaks, etc. Such Testimony has led to millions of dollars in savings in recent years alone. Do not be embarrassed if your post is operating only one, or two programs. Small posts' reports add up to significant totals, but only if your post turns in the report. If a report is not turned in by your post, it will result in possible charter suspension.

INSTALLATION OF 2019-2020 POST OFFICERS DEPARTMENT CONSTITUTION
