We are doing well with our building fundraisers, I could not be happier with the support we have received with our 2nd and 4th Saturday breakfasts at the VFW. We are averaging over 100 patrons. We have never seen numbers like that. It would not be possible without the help of our volunteers and I thank each of you for the continued support. I recently received a donation to our building fund in the amount of \$500 in the memory of one of our local Army Vietnam Veterans, Edward "Glenn" Gageby. He passed away last year. I have thanked the Gageby family for their generous donation. During our Mid-Winter conference, our hospitality room volunteers raised \$1504, all of which went to our building fund. To date we have \$17411.75 in that account and it is growing each month. I thank the VFW for continuing to host our events, and for hosting our Auxiliary, Sons of the American Legion, and Legion Rider meetings. As I stated in my last newsletter, this teamwork between Veteran Service Organizations (VSO) works. I was recently able to speak with our Executive Secretary and Department Adjutant. VSO's teaming up and working together is becoming the norm.

I want to congratulate two Post 14 members, Mike Immel and Brian Tolstyka. Once again, Mike walked away with several awards from the American Legion Department of West Virginia- Best Post History Book, Best Post Yearbook and, the Ben I. Golden Award for Community Service. From the American Legion Sons of the American Legion Detachment of West Virginia, he won the Best Squadron History Book. From the American Legion National side of the house— the Yearbook Contest he was a 2nd Place tie for Mike. His hard work and determination puts our Post history to print for people to enjoy for years to come. Brian won the 2017 Department American Legion Rider of the Year. As one our founding members for Chapter 14, he continues to excel with his leadership abilities. We learned, at Mid-Winter, that Brian and another Rider may be allowed to teach the American Legion College courses at our local Posts to those of us that are unable take a week away from our jobs responsibilities.

Our Post14 Team performed the Mid-Winter opening posting of colors, and did another outstanding job! In case you are unaware, this team has often been requested to perform the various ceremonies throughout the state. On a somber note, the SAL performed the Post Everlasting ceremony for our Brother Steve Wright, the SAL Detachment Commander. We had our annual honoring of Mr. Frank Woodruff Buckle. This is from the Resolution American Legion Post 14 put in and received approval from American Legion Department of West Virginia 93 Convention in June 2011. The ceremony was conducted at the Doughboy Monument yesterday- March 1, 2017. We placed a wreath and said a few words about the life of the Oldest American WW I Veteran. Mr. Buckles lived on his farm outside of Charles Town in Jefferson County. We lost him February 27, 2011. At the Time of his passing he was to oldest American WW I Veteran.
